4 PARTY IN ROME threw in a clunker in her latest outing, but she can rebound. Expect improvement.

3 MANIANA has turned things around since joining the Lasix program for trainer Menary. Triactor factor.

Race 8 Selections 2-3-1-7

2 RISE UP NOW was hard used to make the lead from Post 7 last time and it left him empty in the late going. He gets a good post today. Major danger.

3 FRANCESCETTI held on for a narrow score last time, and he's a prime threat to double up in here.

1 SAULSBROOK PEACH has hit the board in each of his last five assignments. He's a logical contender.

6 MUSCLE MATTERS was a handy RUS winner at Georgian Downs on July 16. The gelding clearly has the speed and skill to handle these. Top call tonight.

5 UPGRADE VALLEY has hit the ticket in five of his last six assignments. He's a logical top three threat.

1. SPORTS COLUMN (\$20,000 Lexington Select) is four starts into his career and he has yet to finish worse than second for trainer Blake MacIntosh. The son of Sportswriter cruised to a handy score in wire-to-wire fashion in his \$15,000 elimination one week ago. He gets the pole position to work from today, and I'll look for him to repeat.

2. CALVIN K (Homebred) overcome a challenging post and then a tough first-over trip to capture his elimination in 1:55.3 for the team of driver Jody Jamieson and trainer Tony O'Sullivan. Jamieson is a three-time 'Battle' champ, while O'Sullivan shoots for his first 'Battle' title. He's the winningest pacer in the field thanks to his three triumphs.

3. HAPPY TRIO (\$55,000 Forest City) was treated to a two-hole trip behind Sports Column in last week's elimination round, but he could gain ground on the leader when they went into sprint mode down the stretch. The colt has been first or second in each of his last three attempts, and that's helped him stash away more than \$83,000.

4. SILVERINYOURPOCKET (\$19,000 Forest City Sale) was a beaten favourite last week after getting a little carried away in the speed department on the front end. He walked home in :30.4, but still managed to take home the show dough. He gets an ideal post to work from today in his quest to bounce back. He merits consideration.

5. MC MACH (Homebred) kicked off his career with an impressive win, but his follow-up performance was anything but impressive. He raced well last week considering how far back he was in the early stages of the mile. Trainer Bob McIntosh shoots for his second 'Battle' title while driver Trevor Henry shoots for his first.

6. CLASSIC PRO (\$45,000 Lexington Select) was three weeks out of the box leading up to last week's elimination performance, and despite that gap in his schedule he turned in a decent effort to finish third. He's one of three maidens in this year's final. His sire, Shadow Play, is looking to produce his first 'Battle' winner.

7. BET ON BRETT (\$80,000 Harrisburg) won at first asking in an OSS Grassroots division on July 7, but he threw in a clunker in his follow-up try one week later. He turned in a respectable effort last week, and in doing so he's advanced to the big dance. His sire, Sportswriter, has yet to produce a 'Battle' champ.

8. DREAMFAIR B J (Homebred) had a rough trip in last week's debut effort, but he still managed to hang on for fifth. In doing so he had a 50/50 chance of drawing into today's final, and as luck would have it – his name was selected to advance while last week's other fifth-place finisher, Test Ride, is the also-eligible.

9. ASTON HILL DAVE (Homebred) has faced the gate three times and he's finished second on all three occasions for Team McNair. Gregg and Doug McNair have won the 'Battle' three times apiece, and this gelding might be the dark horse to give them their fourth title. There's never been a 'Battle' winner from Post 9.
