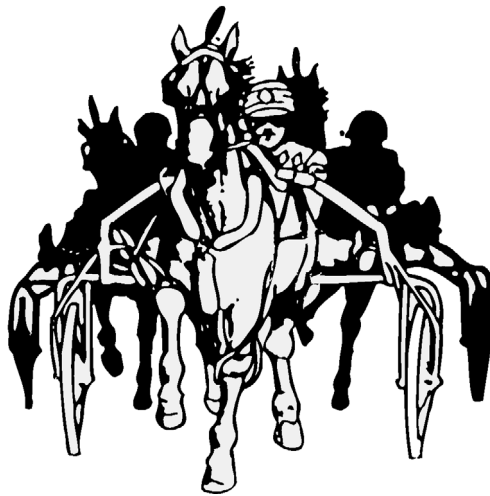

Race 1 Selections 3-4-1-2

3 FARMGIRL TOUGH gets a change of scenery upon returning to action for trainer Moiseyev. The mare qualified in good order on June 1. She gets the nod.

4 SECRETS LADY cruised to a facile victory in her last assignment. She's capable of doubling up.

1 DAN DAR MAL turned in her best starts of the year in her last two outings. She can share once again.

Race 6 Selections 3-6-5-1

3 IN THE NEWS took a sharp mark in early March, and followed up that win with a runner-up effort. The filly clearly has the speed needed to handle these.

6 SHADOW DREAMER totes a two-race winning streak into this contest. She's an Exacta factor here.

5 GET UP N GOUDA was a going away winner in her debut for trainer Bossence. She merits respect again.

Race 2 Selections 6-1-2-9

6 SHESA ICE QUEEN debuts for trainer Pereira and he'll be on the lookout for a maiden breaking score with the daughter of Big Jim. She merits big respect.

1 SHAKEITIFYOUGOTIT makes her debut effort and gets to work from a favourable post. Major danger.

2 GRACEUNDERPRESSURE gets a great post to work from, and that might be enough for her to share.

Race 7 Selections 5-9-1-2

5 SPORTSLINE was one of the top three-year-olds in the OSS program last year, and now he'll look to kick off his four-year-old year with a bang. Top call here.

9 PAR INTENDED is a classy veteran who has to be respected in this spot. I'll use him on the Exacta.

1 RED JOHN gets a great post to work from as he shoots for his second win of the year. Trifecta factor.

Race 3 Selections 1-9-2-4

1 FREEDOM DELIGHT debuts for trainer Bourgault and gets the rail to boot. The daughter of Bettors Delight gets a slight edge versus a beatable group.

9 SHES MAGIC broke her maiden over this oval last summer. She has the speed to be effective in here.

2 KEMPENFELT qualified in good order at Georgian Downs on May 30. She can crack the top three.

Race 8 Selections 7-1-2-3

7 MOON LAKE finds herself in the midst of her final season of racing, and she'll be looking to add to a resume that flaunts 54 wins. She gets the nod.

1 SAULSBROOK CORAL should be able to work out an ideal trip from this inside post. Contender in here.

2 MARCH MAGIC gets a great post to work from in her second start for trainer Shepherd. She can share.

Race 4 Selections 6-1-8-5

6 TAILS AWAY had a terrific season last year, and the last time we saw him he turned in a solid effort to finish third. He has the skill to handle this group.

1 DA NEWS has picked up cheques in each of his last four attempts. He can make some noise in here.

8 LARJON LUCKY turned in a solid qualifier in Clinton on May 31. The outside post is a bummer.

Race 9 Selections 4-1-2-3

4 BET ON BRETT has hit the ticket in all but one of his starts this season, and I'm going to look for that trend to continue in here. He gets the nod tonight.

1 ADORE HIM went 7-for-22 last year and potted more than \$40,000. He merits respect in this spot.

2 PREMIER ROCKSTAR put up solid numbers last year. He tuned up for this tilt with a sharp qualifier.

Race 5 Selections 6-4-5-2

6 FLUENTOCITY has been no worse than second in her last five efforts, and her win total last season was quite impressive. She gets the nod in this spot.

4 ALWAYS A ROSE has won nearly half of her starts this season, and I can see her adding to her numbers.

5 MA REBELLE has been on the board in five of her last six assignments. She's a logical top three threat.

Race 10 Selections 6-1-9-5

6 CHOCOLATE BISKIT was a winning machine last year, but so far this season he's been blanked in his first six attempts. I'm going to look for a win in here.

1 DUC DORLEANS went through the motions in a recent qualifier. The classy veteran is a contender.

9 MISTER X is another classy campaigner who merits respect in this spot. He has the speed to be a threat.

Children

Children are welcome at Grand River Raceway, but must be under adult supervision at ALL times.

Program Policy – Grand River Raceway 'live' racing programs only:

If less than 5 races have run, guests may exchange the program for another 'live' program. The actual canceled program must be presented for exchange. No refunds.

If 5 or more races have run, there will be no exchange.

General Operations

Supervision of the pari-mutuel betting and drug control services is provided by the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency (CPMA), a division of Agriculture Canada, the Honourable Lawrence MacAulay M.P. All pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with these Regulations. All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official. No minor shall purchase or cash a pari-mutuel ticket. Approximate odds represent the probable pay-out price of the win pool at the time they are posted and have no bearing on the pay-out price for any other pool. Where approximate odds for any horse are posted as "1-9", the pay-out price based on a \$2 bet on the win pool may be as low as \$2.10. All tickets should be kept until the result of the race is declared official. No ruling made by the Judges or the Alcohol And Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO) with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools. In the case of foreign separate pool betting, the rules of racing are those of the governing body that regulates the race.

Cancellation Policy

In the event that cancellation of races should result for any reason after four races have been run, no refunds or issuance of rain checks will be made. If a cancellation results before the completion of four races, and upon producing the day's Official Program at the seller's booth, a next day's racing program will be exchanged.

Refunds

Subject to the provisions of the Federal Regulations, all monies bet in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is canceled, declared off, declared no contest or postponed beyond the racing card for which it was scheduled. Subject to the Regulations, all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. Where a horse that is part of an entry is a late scratch and at least one horse of that entry or mutual field starts in the race, all tickets purchased on that entry or mutual field remain valid, and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

Fair Start

The starter shall have control of the horses from the formation of the post parade until a start has been determined. For purpose of this rule, the determination of the start is when the horses have passed the starting point and have been released by the starter. 22.03 (h) There shall be no recall after the horses have been released by the starter. 22.03 (i) The starter shall endeavour to get all horses away in position and on gait. The starter shall only sound a recall for the following reasons: (i) A horse scores ahead of the starting gate; (ii) There is interference before the horses have reached the starting point; (iii) A horse has broken equipment, which the starter notices; (iv) A horse falls before the starting point; (v) A horse coming to the starting gate in the wrong position; (vi) A malfunction of the starting gate or in the interests of safety. 22.03 (l) If a horse has not reached the Fair Start Pole when the horses are released at the starting point by the starter, the judges shall cause the "inquiry" sign to be displayed immediately.

Breaking Rule

When a horse breaks from its gait in a race the driver shall: (a) take the horse to the outside of other horses where clearance exists and; (b) properly attempt to pull the horse to its gait; (c) lose ground while on the break. If there has been no violation of (a), (b) or (c) above, the horse shall not be set back unless a contending horse on its gait is lapped on the hind quarter of the breaking horse at the finish, however, notwithstanding the foregoing, if interference caused by another driver(s) or horse(s) has caused the horse to be on a break at the finish, the judges may, in their discretion determine not to set the horse back even if a contending horse on its gait is lapped on the hind quarter of the breaking horse at the finish. The judges may set any horse back one or more places if, in their judgment, any of the above violations have been committed, or if the horse goes on an extended break, and the driver may be penalized.

Entry or Field in an Exacta

Exacta pools on races that have an entry (1 and 1A and/or 2 and 2B) or mutual field (14f, 15f...) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest (ie. 1-1, 2-2, field-field). If the same betting interest finishes first and second, the exactor payout will be on those horses finishing first and third.

Daily Double & Late Double Betting

Where the daily double feature is operated, the daily double is a betting transaction in which the purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the winners of each of the two races specified for the daily double and that if the purchaser of a daily double ticket fails to pick the winner of the first half of the daily double his bet is void and that all tickets in the second half of the daily double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the daily double are void no matter what circumstances might affect the programmed running of the second half of the daily double. The daily double is operated as an entirely separate pool and is not affected by wagering in other pools operated on the daily double races. Should a horse or horses (not coupled with a starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the daily double after the first race of the daily double has been declared official, holders of all daily double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the daily double race, shall participate in the Consolation Double pool.

Exacta Betting

Where the exacta feature is operated, the exacta is a betting transaction in which the purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two horses to finish, in the exact order of finish, in the race on which the feature is operated.

Trifecta Betting

A Trifecta bet is a betting transaction in which the purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first three horses representing different betting interests to finish, in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the feature is operated.

Superfecta Betting

A Superfecta bet is a betting transaction in which the purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first four horses representing different betting interests to finish, in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the feature is operated.

Super Hi-5 Betting

The Super Hi-5 wager is a betting transaction in which the purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first five horses representing different betting interests to finish, in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the feature is operated. In the event no one correctly selects all five winners in order, 100 per cent of the net pool will be carried over to the next Super Hi-5 race.

Pick-3 or Pick-4 Betting

The Pick-3 and Pick-4 features are betting transactions in which the purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the winners of three or four consecutive races on which the Pick-3 or Pick-4 is scheduled to be run. The winning combination of horses constituting a winning ticket shall be those horses that finish first, in the official order of finish in each leg or feature. When no tickets have been sold on coupling horses finishing first in the official order of finish, there is no winning wager and the pool is refunded. (1) In the event a Pick-3 or Pick-4 feature ticket designates as a selection in any one or more of the races comprising the Pick-3 or Pick-4, a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in the race, the favorite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch(s) occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection for all purposes. (2) In the event that the money bet in the win pool for (2) two or more favorites is identical, the selection identified in the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

Pari-Mutuel Deductions

In Win, Place, Show 13.65% is retained by the Association, in Daily/Late Double, Pick 4, and Super Hi-5, 11.70% is retained by the Association. In Exactor, 17.20% is retained by the Association. In Superfecta, 23.00% is retained by the Association. In Triactor, 21.70% is retained by the Association and there is an extra 2% Provincial Levy. On all wagers there is a 2% Provincial Levy, 0.8% Federal Levy and 0.5% retained by the Ontario Government.

Allowances

Allowances for Ontario Sired horses at Signature tracks is 50% and are based on the condition of the class. Allowances for purse earnings at Signature tracks are 25% for fillies and mares (vs colts and geldings) and are based on the conditions of the race only.

Rule 7.15

No association shall allow a person under 18 years of age to purchase or cash a ticket. For the purposes of this rule, a "ticket" is defined as a receipt or voucher that is issued by an association for one or more bets on a race or races. The association shall ensure that signs are clearly posted in all areas, or in application forms, where tickets are purchased or cashed, advising the public of the age restriction.

Advance Notice Of New Bet Cancellation Options

No claim shall be considered for tickets thrown away, lost, changed, destroyed or mutilated beyond recognition. Payment of wagers will only be made upon presentation of valid pari-mutuel tickets. The following Bet Cancellation Policy is in effect at Grand River Raceway and the Grand River Teletheatre site. A bet can be cancelled up until "stop betting" for the following reasons: 1) A wrong ticket (even after you have left the mutual window) e.g. wrong track; 2) A change in race surface (turf - dirt) or race distance; 3) A scratch of part of an entry (1-1A) or part of a field Self Serve Cancellation; Cancellation of Self Serve Tickets via mutual sellers (see below)
Mutuel Teller Cancellation

1) Open cancellation: ticket must be cancelled prior to stop betting of the race.

2) For tickets of \$100 or more you must write your name, address and telephone number on the back of the ticket before requesting the cancellation. You will also be required to present 1 piece of photo identification to the teller.

When your bets cannot be cancelled:

1) After a pool has been closed (ie betting has been stopped)

2) For tickets of \$100 or more, if photo ID is not presented or a full name, address and telephone number has not been legibly written on the back of the ticket

3) Under circumstances affecting the integrity of a pool or display of pari-mutuel data

4) An officer or the association refuses to cancel and refund the bet under subsection 57
