5 GIMMIE A CORONA showed improvement in her last two outings when reclassified. Exacta factor.

8 GETTING EUCHRED came on strong to finish fourth in last week's return race. Top three threat.

Race 1 Selections 4-5-1-3

4 CASH DEALS was dominant in the final of the City Of London Series in her latest, and I'm going to bank on her being just a vicious tonight. Major danger.

5 ANGELIC KT is a steady type, and that might be all it takes for her to grab the runner-up award in here.

1 KENOGAMI COURGAGE had a solid rookie year, but she's struggled in 2023. Expect improvement.

Race 7 Selections 5-1-6-2

5 TACTICAL SEELSTER totes a two-race winning streak into this assignment for trainer Demers, who has to be pleased with this one's progress. Top call.

1 MORNING WATCH has hit the board in more than half of his starts in 2023. He merits serious respect.

6 ACEFORTYFOUR BOLT has yet to miss the board this season. He can crack the top three once again.

Race 2 Selections 2-7-1-3

2 MAGNETAR SEELSTER gets some post relief to work with tonight, and that might be the edge he needs to break his maiden. He gets the nod in here.

7 BET ON IT looks to rebound from a poor showing in his latest. He can bounce back and be a threat.

1 IRRESISTABLE rallied to grab the show dough last time. He has the speed to crack the top three again.

Race 8 Selections 3-1-2-7

3 OH GOUDA was done in by a challenging post in the final of the City Of London, but prior to that she'd been incredibly productive. She can rebound in here.

1 TWIN B ECHO appears primed and ready for her 2023 debut for trainer Darling. She merits respect.

2 PREVAIL SEELSTER has been first or second in each of her last three attempts. Logical contender.

Race 3 Selections 3-1-2-5

3 SANT AMBROGGIO was a speedy runner-up last time after tagging along and trotting her own mile in 1:59.1. She merits major consideration in this spot.

1 CUNNING CONNIE has struggled to regain last year's solid form. She might be able to regroup here.

2 CHAMPAGNE BETTINA went a long way on the lead in her latest. She has the speed to be a factor.

Race 9 Selections 4-5-6-9

4 CRANBERRY BRIE has put together a solid record so far this season, and I can see her bolstering her totals with another strong showing in here. Top call.

5 CINDERELLA DELIGHT endured a tough trip last time and came away with a win. She can double up.

6 RUNAWAY HEIRESS has shown improvement in her last three attempts. She can crack the top three.

Race 4 Selections 7-5-3-4

7 MAPLE has really turned things around in her last four assignments. She's now 2-for-2 since moving into the barn of trainer Waxman. The one to beat.

5 TWO ACROSS MARION broke her maiden in style last week when she clicked in 1:56.4. Exacta factor.

3 CONTROLTHEDISTANCE turned in her best effort of the season in her latest. She's a top three threat.

Race 10 Selections 7-2-4-3

7 ARTSALIVE gets a change of scenery as he returns to action following some time away. I'll bank on trainer Marfisi having him on his toes in this spot.

2 UP JOEYS CREDIT took his game to a new level in his latest victory. An inside post adds to his appeal.

4 INDIGENOUS HANOVER gets cheques regularly, but has yet to win a race. He can hit the ticket tonight.

Race 5 Selections 4-7-8-9

4 AHOY flashed 1:53.2 speed in a recent road trip to Flamboro Downs for trainer Moreau. The mare has a class and speed edge on this group. Top call in here.

7 MANHATTAN NIGHT has hit the ticket in nearly half of her starts in 2023. She merits respect again.

8 SAULSBROOK JESSIE did all of the road work last time but got picked off late. She's a top three threat.

Race 11 Selections 2-1-5-3

2 KATYS DELIGHT gets a change of scenery and has a solid post to work with as she shoots for her second win of the season. She can improve tonight.

1 COME OUT AND PLAY showed high speed when picking up a small share last time. Exacta factor.

5 BIG DIAMOND should appreciate the venue change for Team MacDonald. Top three threat.

Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

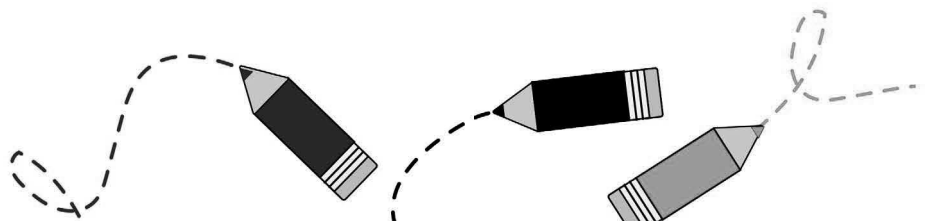

COSA BENEFITS

COSA LIABILITY INSURANCE COVERAGE HORSE RELATED (INCLUDED IN MEMBERSHIP)

COSA offers liability insurance to all standardbred horsepeople on an additional third party basis. The limits of the policy are 2 million per occurrence.

The policy is intended to cover horse-related incidents in which you may become legally liable through a law suit by a third party.

COSA LIABILITY INSURANCE COVERAGE INDIVIDUALS (INCLUDED IN MEMBERSHIP)

This policy provides liability insurance to all standardbred horsepeople participating at a "scheduled" Ontario racetrack for incidents which horsepeople may become legally liable as the result of property damage or bodily injury.

The policy will not cover injury or death to any animal or injury or death to any person participating in training or racing of standardbred horses on the racing surface.

COSA SUPPLEMENTAL DISABILITY (INCLUDED IN MEMBERSHIP)

This policy financially assists COSA members during the recuperation period of a horse-related accident, which took place in Ontario. The policy pays an additional 50% as per the Standardbred Canada guidelines below. Coverage is provided by COSA in full for up to two years. However, the COSA policy only allows members receiving this benefit an opportunity to collect for a maximum of 24 months over a five-year period.

COSA FIRE & TRANSPORTATION (INCLUDED IN MEMBERSHIP)

This program provides fire and transportation insurance to horsepeople who are participating at "scheduled" Ontario racetracks with additional fire and transportation insurance. All horsepeople are covered for losses incurred from a collision or "overturn" of the conveying vehicle while transporting to and from a racetrack where the horse is entered to race.

Limits of liability include \$25,000 per horse, \$7,500 per horse two years or older who has not started and \$2,500 for tack per horse. In the event this coverage becomes primary, any loss incurred by this policy is subject to a \$500 deductible per claim. Maximum claims allowed are \$7,500 for tack and \$250,000 total for any single occurrence.

COSA LIFE - HEALTH - DENTAL (OPTIONAL)

Through your COSA membership Ontario residents are eligible to join the RWAM Insurance Group Benefit Plan. The plan is available to COSA members and their families and covers: Life Insurance \$20,000; Accidental Death and Dismemberment \$30,000; Dependent Life-spouse \$5,000 and each child \$2,500; Healthcare including prescription drugs, paramedical services, private duty nurse, ambulance plus out-of-country coverage, all covered at 80% and Dental Care which covers 80% of cleaning, scaling, polishing, fluoride treatments, fillings, extraction, denture repairs, etc. plus 50% coverage for removable dentures.

Children

Children are welcome at Grand River Raceway, but must be under adult supervision at ALL times.

Program Policy – Grand River Raceway 'live' racing programs only:

If less than 5 races have run, guests may exchange the program for another 'live' program. The actual canceled program must be presented for exchange. No refunds.

If 5 or more races have run, there will be no exchange.

General Operations

Supervision of the pari-mutuel betting and drug control services is provided by the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency (CPMA), a division of Agriculture Canada. All pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with these Regulations. All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official. No minor shall purchase or cash a pari-mutuel ticket. Approximate odds represent the probable pay-out price of the win pool at the time they are posted and have no bearing on the pay-out price for any other pool. Where approximate odds for any horse are posted as "1-9", the pay-out price based on a \$2 bet on the win pool may be as low as \$2.10. All tickets should be kept until the result of the race is declared official. No ruling made by the Judges or the Alcohol And Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO) with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools. In the case of foreign separate pool betting, the rules of racing are those of the governing body that regulates the race.

Cancellation Policy

In the event that cancellation of races should result for any reason after four races have been run, no refunds or issuance of rain checks will be made. If a cancellation results before the completion of four races, and upon producing the day's Official Program at the seller's booth, a next day's racing program will be exchanged.

Refunds

Subject to the provisions of the Federal Regulations, all monies bet in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is canceled, declared off, declared no contest or postponed beyond the racing card for which it was scheduled. Subject to the Regulations, all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. Where a horse that is part of an entry is a late scratch and at least one horse of that entry or mutual field starts in the race, all tickets purchased on that entry or mutual field remain valid, and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

Fair Start

The starter shall have control of the horses from the formation of the post parade until a start has been determined. For purpose of this rule, the determination of the start is when the horses have passed the starting point and have been released by the starter. 22.03 (h) There shall be no recall after the horses have been released by the starter. 22.03 (i) The starter shall endeavour to get all horses away in position and on gait. The starter shall only sound a recall for the following reasons: (i) A horse scores ahead of the starting gate; (ii) There is interference before the horses have reached the starting point; (iii) A horse has broken equipment, which the starter notices; (iv) A horse falls before the starting point; (v) A horse coming to the starting gate in the wrong position; (vi) A malfunction of the starting gate or in the interests of safety. 22.03 (l) If a horse has not reached the Fair Start Pole when the horses are released at the starting point by the starter, the judges shall cause the "inquiry" sign to be displayed immediately.

Breaking Rule

When a horse breaks from its gait in a race the driver shall: (a) take the horse to the outside of other horses where clearance exists and; (b) properly attempt to pull the horse to its gait; (c) lose ground while on the break. If there has been no violation of (a), (b) or (c) above, the horse shall not be set back unless a contending horse on its gait is lapped on the hind quarter of the breaking horse at the finish, however, notwithstanding the foregoing, if interference caused by another driver(s) or horse(s) has caused the horse to be on a break at the finish, the judges may, in their discretion determine not to set the horse back even if a contending horse on its gait is lapped on the hind quarter of the breaking horse at the finish. The judges may set any horse back one or more places if, in their judgment, any of the above violations have been committed, or if the horse goes on an extended break, and the driver may be penalized.

Entry or Field in an Exacta

Exacta pools on races that have an entry (1 and 1A and/or 2 and 2B) or mutual field (14f, 15f...) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest (ie. 1-1, 2-2, field-field). If the same betting interest finishes first and second, the exactor payout will be on those horses finishing first and third.

Daily Double & Late Double Betting

Where the daily double feature is operated, the daily double is a betting transaction in which the purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the winners of each of the two races specified for the daily double and that if the purchaser of a daily double ticket fails to pick the winner of the first half of the daily double his bet is void and that all tickets in the second half of the daily double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the daily double are void no matter what circumstances might affect the programmed running of the second half of the daily double. The daily double is operated as an entirely separate pool and is not affected by wagering in other pools operated on the daily double races. Should a horse or horses (not coupled with a starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the daily double after the first race of the daily double has been declared official, holders of all daily double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the daily double race, shall participate in the Consolation Double pool.

Exacta Betting

Where the exacta feature is operated, the exacta is a betting transaction in which the purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two horses to finish, in the exact order of finish, in the race on which the feature is operated.

Trifecta Betting

A Trifecta bet is a betting transaction in which the purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first three horses representing different betting interests to finish, in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the feature is operated.

Superfecta Betting

A Superfecta bet is a betting transaction in which the purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first four horses representing different betting interests to finish, in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the feature is operated.

Super Hi-5 Betting

The Super Hi-5 wager is a betting transaction in which the purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first five horses representing different betting interests to finish, in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the feature is operated. In the event no one correctly selects all five winners in order, 100 per cent of the net pool will be carried over to the next Super Hi-5 race.

Pick-3 or Pick-4 Betting

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively. Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

Pick 5 Betting

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively. If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

Pick 3, Pick 4 & Pick 5 Scratches

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection. However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

Pari-Mutuel Deductions

The Association deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed on Grand River Raceway in Ontario which are then shared with the horsepeople. Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers and an additional 2% on trifecta wagering. The Ontario Government retains .5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government retains .8% on all wagers placed in Canada.
Win, Place, Show: 13.65%, Exacta: 17.2%, Trifecta: 21.7%, Super: 23%; all other pools: 11.7%.

Allowances

Allowances for Ontario Sired horses at Signature tracks is 50% and are based on the condition of the class. Allowances for purse earnings at Signature tracks are 25% for fillies and mares (vs colts and geldings) and are based on the conditions of the race only.

Rule 7.15

No association shall allow a person under 18 years of age to purchase or cash a ticket. For the purposes of this rule, a "ticket" is defined as a receipt or voucher that is issued by an association for one or more bets on a race or races. The association shall ensure that signs are clearly posted in all areas, or in application forms, where tickets are purchased or cashed, advising the public of the age restriction.

Advance Notice Of New Bet Cancellation Options

No claim shall be considered for tickets thrown away, lost, changed, destroyed or mutilated beyond recognition. Payment of wagers will only be made upon presentation of valid parimutuel tickets. The following Bet Cancellation Policy is in effect at Grand River Raceway and the Grand River Teletheatre site. A bet can be cancelled up until "stop betting" for the following reasons: 1) A wrong ticket (even after you have left the mutual window) e.g. wrong track; 2) A change in race surface (turf - dirt) or race distance; 3) A scratch of part of an entry (1-1A) or part of a field Self Serve Cancellation; Cancellation of Self Serve Tickets via mutual sellers (see below)

Mutuel Teller Cancellation

1) Open cancellation: ticket must be cancelled prior to stop betting of the race.
2) For tickets of \$100 or more you must write your name, address and telephone number on the back of the ticket before requesting the cancellation. You will also be required to present 1 piece of photo identification to the teller.

When your bets cannot be cancelled:

- 1) After a pool has been closed (ie betting has been stopped)
- 2) For tickets of \$100 or more, if photo ID is not presented or a full name, address and telephone number has not been legibly written on the back of the ticket
- 3) Under circumstances affecting the integrity of a pool or display of pari-mutuel data
- 4) An officer or the association refuses to cancel and refund the bet under subsection 57
