Race 6 Selections 3-5-1-2

3 CENTURY KOMODO is the hot horse coming into this contest considering he's been first or second in each of his last four assignments. Major danger here.

5 MCWICKED TIME earned a new speed badge at Mohawk Park two starts ago. He merits a long look.

1 DANCELIKE EHSKIPPER has nabbed cheques in five of his last six assignments. Trifecta factor again.

Race 1 Selections 1-3-6-4

1 AMAZING WISH was an impressive winner in her debut. That 1:56 score was versus two-year-olds and now she goes into deeper waters. She gets the nod.

3 BIG NIPPER has been first or second in 50% of her starts this year. Her consistency merits big respect.

6 TWIN B NANCYS WISH has shown improvement in her last two outings. She can keep the ball rolling.

Race 7 Selections 1-2-7-5

1 MCPLEASANT comes into this assignment riding a two-race winning streak for trainer Beaton, who could be in store for a big afternoon. The one to beat today.

2 ALWAYS A THRILL came up just short last time in what was a solid performance. He's a logical threat.

7 STONEBRIDGE THRILL blasted home in :27.1 in his latest and just missed getting there. Contender.

Race 2 Selections 3-4-6-7

3 MARVIN HAGLER has hit the board in four of his last five outings and he enters this tilt fresh off of his triumph in the Vic Hayter Memorial. Top call here.

4 PRINCE ARCHIE went to the front and didn't look back in his latest en route to a big score. Contender.

6 VILLEFRANCHE AS has been a steady on the board type, but wins have been hard to come by.

Race 8 Selections 1-2-9-8

1 THE VICAR hauled home a new lifetime mark last time when he toured Mohawk Park's oval in 1:50.3. The rail adds to his appeal in this contest. Top call.

2 TAMWORTH BOY was a lapped-on third in his most recent performance. Exacta factor in this spot.

9 DO BETTER made a costly break in his latest and finished up the track. He can bounce back in here.

Race 3 Selections 5-4-1-6

5 WAYWARD BLUE CHIP made a costly, late break in her debut and wound up finishing with broken gear. She can bounce back against this beatable bunch.

4 BEACH GAMES was no match for Mohawk Park foes in her debut. She should find this group easier.

1 MYMOMSANACE rallied to finish fourth in her debut. It was a solid performance for the homebred.

Race 9 Selections 6-1-3-2

6 IDEAL PERCEPTION moves back up to the top class after a set of solid efforts versus easier foes. He's a high speed type who is extremely versatile.

1 PALLADIUM HANOVER lacked staying power in his latest outing, but he's the type that can rebound.

3 NIGHTIME DANCER has been fairly productive in recent weeks for trainer Boyd. Trifecta factor today.

Race 4 Selections 5-6-2-4

5 MACALLAN went the trip of his life last week when he toured the oval in 1:52.3 – an all-age track record. Cullen is listed again in the gelding's quest to repeat.

6 DELCREST BRENT got stuck in traffic last time and it cost him any chance of sharing. He can rebound.

2 GRATEFUL gets a change of scenery in his debut for new connections. He can be a top three threat.

Race 10 Selections 4-5-1-9

4 PERFECTLY CHIC has yet to finish worse than second in her career, and I don't see that changing this afternoon. She has the tools to win once again.

5 WICKED N SINGLE disappointed as the favourite last week, but she still raced well. Exacta factor here.

1 MANHATTAN MAYHEM turned in a strong rally last week en route to a 1:53 triumph. Top three threat.

Race 5 Selections 4-1-5-2

4 WOODMERE ROLLNPOP is already a seven-time winner this year. The gelding was on point in June, but he's slid a bit since then. He can bounce back.

1 THRILLING TIMES hit the board in back to back starts and now gets to operate from the pole position.

5 LORD ANTHONY gets post relief and a change of scenery this afternoon. He can complete the Trifecta.

Race 11 Selections 2-6-1-5

2 FIFTH AND FIVE set a new track record last week when he dazzled us all with a 1:51.3 score for Team Jamieson. He'll be hard to beat with a repeat effort.

6 ALLSTAR MANIAC came on strong to grab the runner-up award last week. He merits major respect.

1 STERLING CHOICE goes from one extreme to the other in the post position department. He can share.

Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

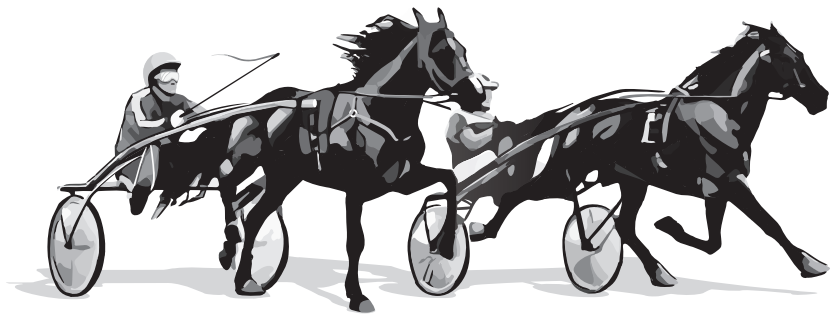
Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1
Pays	\$3.00	\$6.00	\$9.00	\$12.00	\$22.00

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

Today's 'Button Up Preferred', for top aged pacers, is a race dedicated to the memory of one of our Industry Day's top performers over the years.

Bred by Bill Andrew and Dr. Fred Kruszelnicki of Alberta, Button Up sold for \$18,000 as a yearling, in 2004, at the Kentucky Standardbred Yearling Sale. Campaigned throughout his entire racing career by Mark Horner, the son of Northern Luck was a game performer winning 49 races with many of those victories coming on the smaller half-mile tracks of Ontario. After twelve years of racing, strictly in this province, Button Up retired with \$824,000 in career earnings – with much of that banked as a hard-knocking aged pacer.

His life best winning mark would come as a four-year-old, right here at Grand River Raceway, where he would circle the field in our 'Industry Day Preferred' to post a mild upset in 1:52 flat. His richest payday would come as a two-year-old in the 2005 edition of the \$300,000 Battle Of Waterloo – again right here – where he'd pace away from his rivals to win by seven lengths in 1:56.2 with his longtime driver, Mike Horner, aboard. That win would be the beginning of a very special streak that Mark Horner is particularly proud of – to this day.

"Button Up is undefeated on Industry Day at Grand River," he says. "He won the 'Battle' there in 2005 and then won the Preferred, on the undercard, as an aged pacer in 2007, 2010 and 2012. He loved that track and his home track of London in particular. He was great gaited and durable – two of his best attributes.

After his retirement from racing, at age 13, Button Up lived out his remaining days on Horner's farm until his passing at age 17.

It's a tremendous honour that Grand River wants to recognize a local horse – it certainly means a lot to me. He was a great horse – he had the will to compete and win and he was tough as nails every time he raced!

Children

Children are welcome at Grand River Raceway, but must be under adult supervision at ALL times.

Racing Policy – Grand River Raceway 'live' racing programs only:

If less than 5 races have run, guests may exchange the program for another 'live' program. The actual canceled program must be presented for exchange. No refunds.

If 5 or more races have run, there will be no exchange.

General Operations

Supervision of the pari-mutuel betting and drug control services is provided by the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency (CPMA), a division of Agriculture Canada. All pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with these Regulations. All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official. No minor shall purchase or cash a pari-mutuel ticket. Approximate odds represent the probable pay-out price of the win pool at the time they are posted and have no bearing on the pay-out price for any other pool. Where approximate odds for any horse are posted as "1-9", the pay-out price based on a \$2 bet on the win pool may be as low as \$2.10. All tickets should be kept until the result of the race is declared official. No ruling made by the Judges or the Alcohol And Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO) with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools. In the case of foreign separate pool betting, the rules of racing are those of the governing body that regulates the race.

Cancellation Policy

In the event that cancellation of races should result for any reason after four races have been run, no refunds or issuance of rain checks will be made. If a cancellation results before the completion of four races, and upon producing the day's Official Program at the seller's booth, a next day's racing program will be exchanged.

Refunds

Subject to the provisions of the Federal Regulations, all monies bet in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is canceled, declared off, declared no contest or postponed beyond the racing card for which it was scheduled. Subject to the Regulations, all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. Where a horse that is part of an entry is a late scratch and at least one horse of that entry or mutual field starts in the race, all tickets purchased on that entry or mutual field remain valid, and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

Fair Start

The starter shall have control of the horses from the formation of the post parade until a start has been determined. For purpose of this rule, the determination of the start is when the horses have passed the starting point and have been released by the starter. 22.03 (h) There shall be no recall after the horses have been released by the starter. 22.03 (i) The starter shall endeavour to get all horses away in position and on gait. The starter shall only sound a recall for the following reasons: (i) A horse scores ahead of the starting gate; (ii) There is interference before the horses have reached the starting point; (iii) A horse has broken equipment, which the starter notices; (iv) A horse falls before the starting point; (v) A horse coming to the starting gate in the wrong position; (vi) A malfunction of the starting gate or in the interests of safety. 22.03 (l) If a horse has not reached the Fair Start Pole when the horses are released at the starting point by the starter, the judges shall cause the "inquiry" sign to be displayed immediately.

Breaking Rule

When a horse breaks from its gait in a race the driver shall: (a) take the horse to the outside of other horses where clearance exists and; (b) properly attempt to pull the horse to its gait; (c) lose ground while on the break. If there has been no violation of (a), (b) or (c) above, the horse shall not be set back unless a contending horse on its gait is lapped on the hind quarter of the breaking horse at the finish, however, notwithstanding the foregoing, if interference caused by another driver(s) or horse(s) has caused the horse to be on a break at the finish, the judges may, in their discretion determine not to set the horse back even if a contending horse on its gait is lapped on the hind quarter of the breaking horse at the finish. The judges may set any horse back one or more places if, in their judgment, any of the above violations have been committed, or if the horse goes on an extended break, and the driver may be penalized.

Entry or Field in an Exacta

Exacta pools on races that have an entry (1 and 1A and/or 2 and 2B) or mutual field (14f, 15f...) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest (ie. 1-1, 2-2, field-field). If the same betting interest finishes first and second, the exactor payout will be on those horses finishing first and third.

Daily Double & Late Double Betting

Where the daily double feature is operated, the daily double is a betting transaction in which the purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the winners of each of the two races specified for the daily double and that if the purchaser of a daily double ticket fails to pick the winner of the first half of the daily double his bet is void and that all tickets in the second half of the daily double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the daily double are void no matter what circumstances might affect the programmed running of the second half of the daily double. The daily double is operated as an entirely separate pool and is not affected by wagering in other pools operated on the daily double races. Should a horse or horses (not coupled with a starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the daily double after the first race of the daily double has been declared official, holders of all daily double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the daily double race, shall participate in the Consolation Double pool.

Exacta Betting

Where the exacta feature is operated, the exacta is a betting transaction in which the purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two horses to finish, in the exact order of finish, in the race on which the feature is operated.

Trifecta Betting

A Trifecta bet is a betting transaction in which the purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first three horses representing different betting interests to finish, in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the feature is operated.

Superfecta Betting

A Superfecta bet is a betting transaction in which the purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first four horses representing different betting interests to finish, in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the feature is operated.

Super Hi-5 Betting

The Super Hi-5 wager is a betting transaction in which the purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first five horses representing different betting interests to finish, in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the feature is operated. In the event no one correctly selects all five winners in order, 100 per cent of the net pool will be carried over to the next Super Hi-5 race.

Pick-3 or Pick-4 Betting

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively. Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

Pick 5 Betting

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively. If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available Pick 5.

Pick 3, Pick 4 & Pick 5 Scratches

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection. However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

Pari-Mutuel Deductions

The Association deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed on Grand River Raceway in Ontario which are then shared with the horsepeople. Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers and an additional 2% on trifecta wagering. The Ontario Government retains .5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government retains .8% on all wagers placed in Canada.

Win, Place, Show: 13.65%, Exacta: 17.2%, Trifecta: 21.7%, Super: 23%; all other pools: 11.7%.

Allowances

Allowances for Ontario Sired horses at Signature tracks is 50% and are based on the condition of the class. Allowances for purse earnings at Signature tracks are 25% for fillies and mares (vs colts and geldings) and are based on the conditions of the race only.

Rule 7.15

No association shall allow a person under 18 years of age to purchase or cash a ticket. For the purposes of this rule, a "ticket" is defined as a receipt or voucher that is issued by an association for one or more bets on a race or races. The association shall ensure that signs are clearly posted in all areas, or in application forms, where tickets are purchased or cashed, advising the public of the age restriction.

Advance Notice Of New Bet Cancellation Options

No claim shall be considered for tickets thrown away, lost, changed, destroyed or mutilated beyond recognition. Payment of wagers will only be made upon presentation of valid parimutuel tickets. The following Bet Cancellation Policy is in effect at Grand River Raceway and the Grand River Teletheatre site. A bet can be cancelled up until "stop betting" for the following reasons: 1) A wrong ticket (even after you have left the mutual window) e.g. wrong track; 2) A change in race surface (turf - dirt) or race distance; 3) A scratch of part of an entry (1-1A) or part of a field Self Serve Cancellation; Cancellation of Self Serve Tickets via mutual sellers (see below)

Mutuel Teller Cancellation

1) Open cancellation: ticket must be cancelled prior to stop betting of the race.

2) For tickets of \$100 or more you must write your name, address and telephone number on the back of the ticket before requesting the cancellation. You will also be required to present 1 piece of photo identification to the teller.

When your bets cannot be cancelled:

1) After a pool has been closed (ie betting has been stopped)

2) For tickets of \$100 or more, if photo ID is not presented or a full name, address and telephone number has not been legibly written on the back of the ticket

3) Under circumstances affecting the integrity of a pool or display of pari-mutuel data

4) An officer or the association refuses to cancel and refund the bet under subsection 57

Children
