Race 5 Selections 7-5-6-3

7 TALBOT EHBESEA gets in with a softer group this evening after struggling in her first four attempts versus foes at Mohawk Park. She can handle these.

5 ENDSWELL STATION tagged along to be a solid runner-up in a recent prep. She merits major respect.

6 TH AVERY debuts for new trainer Parish. She was able to grab the show dough in her debut. Contender.

Race 1 Selections 1-2-4-6

1 EYE OF AN EAGLE has hit the ticket in each of his last three assignments. He finally draws an inside post for Team Hensley. I'll give him the nod tonight.

2 JEANIE T did good things in her last two outings over this oval. Her inside post makes her a big threat.

4 GAMING QUEEN went a long way on the lead last time before finishing second. Top three threat again.

Race 6 Selections 2-5-4-6

2 SHETROTSALOT was no match for OSS Gold foes last time, but she was impressive in her previous outing versus easier. She can bounce back in here.

5 ELECTRIC JANE went home empty handed in her last two outings at Mohawk Park. She can improve.

4 INTUITIVE has hit the ticket in nine of 13 starts this year. She gets an improved post to work with tonight.

Race 2 Selections 6-1-3-5

6 GIMMIE A CORONA has hit the ticket in half of her starts this season for trainer Crone, and I'll look for that trend to continue in this spot. She gets the nod.

1 KELLINA DIAMOND has had mixed results since returning from some down time. Exacta factor here.

3 ULTIMATE TWIX lacked staying power in her latest outing but I'll look for her to rebound. Trifecta factor.

Race 7 Selections 1-4-2-3

1 CHAUD HOLLIDAY has only missed the board twice this season for trainer Holliday. She has to be considered a prime win threat from the rail. Top call.

4 ANCIENT WALL has picked up cheques in four of her five tries for trainer Ruhl. Exacta factor in here.

2 ULTRA LADY S was no match for Mohawk Park foes in her latest. Look for improvement in this spot.

Race 3 Selections 2-1-5-4

2 CHIP HAPPENED came up a neck short in last week's quest to break his maiden. The gelding gets a great post to work from tonight. He's the one to beat.

1 GAELIC PIPER is a combined 0-for-23 in the last two seasons, but he still merits major respect in here.

5 KADABRAKABOOM rallied to take home a small share in his latest assignment. He can share again.

Race 8 Selections 3-1-4-6

3 TWILIGHT SURPRISE kicked home in :29 to finish fourth in her latest. She trotted in 1:58.2 that night and that type of speed makes her a major win threat.

1 BELVEDERE FRANKLIN nabbed the show dough in his last two assignments. Exacta factor in this spot.

4 FASTNET ROCK went home empty handed last time, but I can see her improving and sharing in here.

Race 4 Selections 1-2-6-3

1 D A MAGIC MIKE battled hard in the middle stages of his latest effort before leveling off and winding up third. He can do some serious damage from the rail.

2 HAPPY NEIGHS has taken home prizes in four of his last five attempts. I'll use him on the Exacta ticket.

6 ALADDIN DU LAC was never a factor versus much tougher foes last time. He can rebound in this spot.

Race 9 Selections 7-8-1-9

7 JGS PAL totes a four-race winning streak into this contest for trainer Lawrence. The gelding is quite versatile and he clearly has the speed to win again.

8 MASS MONEY has made 10 starts this year and she has yet to be worse than second. Major danger.

1 M I RADICAL was a handy winner in his latest and from the rail he can play a major role once again.

Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

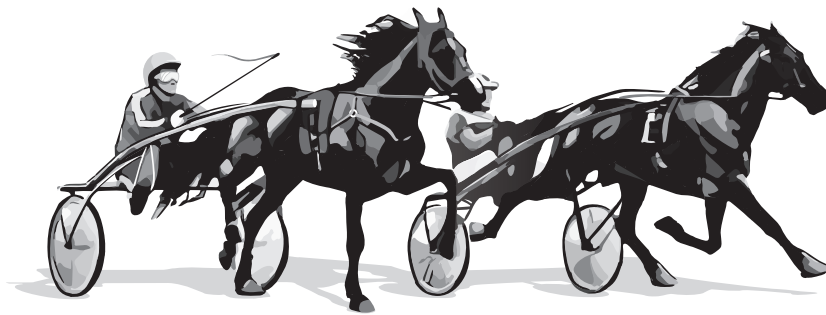
Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	UUU	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	UU	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	UUUU	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	UUUUUU	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	UUUUUUUU	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	UUUUUUUU	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	UUUUUUUUUU	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- Horse's number in the race
- Horse's post position colour
- Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- Morning line odds
- Horse's name
- Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)

- Trainer information
- Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1
Pays	\$3.00	\$6.00	\$9.00	\$12.00	\$22.00

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

Harness Racing GLOSSARY OF TERMS

BOXED IN: A horse that is racing on the rail and is surrounded by other horses in front, outside and behind it. A horse that is boxed in is held up and unable to gain a clear passage.

BREAK: To start galloping and lose the natural trotting or pacing rhythm. This occurs more often with trotters than pacers.

CARD: Another term for a program of racing. For example, a person may refer to there being twelve races on the card, which simply means twelve races will be staged on that particular day.

CATCH DRIVER: A driver which does not train his or her own horses and is engaged by other trainers to drive their horses.

CLAIMING RACE: A race where any of the entrants may be claimed (purchased) for a specified amount.

COLORS: The colorful suit (also called "silks") worn by drivers/trainers. Unlike Thoroughbred racing, the drivers/trainers register their own colors and wear them every time they race.

COLT: A male 3 years of age or less.

CONDITIONED RACE: A race where eligibility is based on age, sex, money won, or races won. For example, "3-year-old colts who are non-winners of \$10,000 lifetime or 4 races."

COVER: A horse that races with another horse in front of him is said to race with cover, as the leading horse cuts the wind resistance.

DEAD HEAT: A situation in which the judges cannot separate two or more horses when judging the outcome of a race. This race is declared a tie (Dead Heat).

DISTANCED: A horse that is out of touch with the rest of the field at the end of the race. This is often referred to as "finished distanced".

FIRST-OVER: The first horse to make a move on the leader in a race, moving up on the outside.

FREE LEGGED: A pacer which races without wearing hobbles.

HOME STRETCH: The straight length of the track, nearest the spectators, heading toward the finish line. It is called this because it is the final part of the track a horse travels down on its way 'home' (or the finish line).

HOPPLES: The straps which connect the front and rear legs on the same side of a horse. Most pacers wear hobbles to help balance their stride and maintain a pacing gait. The length of hobbles is adjustable and a trainer registers the length that best suits his or her horse. There are also trotting hobbles that work through a pulley system to help trotters maintain their gait.

INQUIRY: Judging officials may conduct an inquiry as a result of any incident which may have occurred during a race, to determine whether or not certain drivers and/or horses were responsible for the incident.

PACER: Are horses whose legs move in a lateral motion, meaning the two legs on the same side of the body move in unison. For example, both right legs move forward as both left legs are going back.

PARKED: A horse racing on the outside, with at least one horse between it and the inside rail.

PHOTO FINISH: When two horses cross the finish line too closely to identify a winner, officials call for a photograph of the race, taken exactly at the finish line, to help them determine which nose is ahead.

POCKET: A horse in a pocket is unable to obtain a clear path because it has other horses situated in front, behind and to the side of it.

POST TIME: Start of the race.

QUALIFIER: A race in which a horse must contest a mile below an established time standard to prove itself capable of competing in pari-mutuel races.

STANDARD BRED: The breed of horse which competes in harness races.

SULKY: Also known as the cart or racebike, the sulky is attached to the harness and carries the driver.

TOTE BOARD: An electronic board, usually in the infield of a track, which posts the odds, amount of money bet, results of a race and the wagering pay-offs.

TROTTER: Horses whose legs on the opposite side of the body move at the same time. For example, the right front and left rear move forward as the left front and right rear move back.

Children

Children are welcome at Grand River Raceway, but must be under adult supervision at ALL times.

Racing Policy – Grand River Raceway 'live' racing programs only:

If less than 5 races have run, guests may exchange the program for another 'live' program. The actual canceled program must be presented for exchange. No refunds.

If 5 or more races have run, there will be no exchange.

General Operations

Supervision of the pari-mutuel betting and drug control services is provided by the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency (CPMA), a division of Agriculture Canada. All pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with these Regulations. All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official. No minor shall purchase or cash a pari-mutuel ticket. Approximate odds represent the probable pay-out price of the win pool at the time they are posted and have no bearing on the pay-out price for any other pool. Where approximate odds for any horse are posted as "1-9", the pay-out price based on a \$2 bet on the win pool may be as low as \$2.10. All tickets should be kept until the result of the race is declared official. No ruling made by the Judges or the Alcohol And Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO) with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools. In the case of foreign separate pool betting, the rules of racing are those of the governing body that regulates the race.

Cancellation Policy

In the event that cancellation of races should result for any reason after four races have been run, no refunds or issuance of rain checks will be made. If a cancellation results before the completion of four races, and upon producing the day's Official Program at the seller's booth, a next day's racing program will be exchanged.

Refunds

Subject to the provisions of the Federal Regulations, all monies bet in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is canceled, declared off, declared no contest or postponed beyond the racing card for which it was scheduled. Subject to the Regulations, all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. Where a horse that is part of an entry is a late scratch and at least one horse of that entry or mutual field starts in the race, all tickets purchased on that entry or mutual field remain valid, and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

Fair Start

The starter shall have control of the horses from the formation of the post parade until a start has been determined. For purpose of this rule, the determination of the start is when the horses have passed the starting point and have been released by the starter. 22.03 (h) There shall be no recall after the horses have been released by the starter. 22.03 (i) The starter shall endeavour to get all horses away in position and on gait. The starter shall only sound a recall for the following reasons: (i) A horse scores ahead of the starting gate; (ii) There is interference before the horses have reached the starting point; (iii) A horse has broken equipment, which the starter notices; (iv) A horse falls before the starting point; (v) A horse coming to the starting gate in the wrong position; (vi) A malfunction of the starting gate or in the interests of safety. 22.03 (l) If a horse has not reached the Fair Start Pole when the horses are released at the starting point by the starter, the judges shall cause the "inquiry" sign to be displayed immediately.

Breaking Rule

When a horse breaks from its gait in a race the driver shall: (a) take the horse to the outside of other horses where clearance exists and; (b) properly attempt to pull the horse to its gait; (c) lose ground while on the break. If there has been no violation of (a), (b) or (c) above, the horse shall not be set back unless a contending horse on its gait is lapped on the hind quarter of the breaking horse at the finish, however, notwithstanding the foregoing, if interference caused by another driver(s) or horse(s) has caused the horse to be on a break at the finish, the judges may, in their discretion determine not to set the horse back even if a contending horse on its gait is lapped on the hind quarter of the breaking horse at the finish. The judges may set any horse back one or more places if, in their judgment, any of the above violations have been committed, or if the horse goes on an extended break, and the driver may be penalized.

Entry or Field in an Exacta

Exactor pools on races that have an entry (1 and 1A and/or 2 and 2B) or mutual field (14f, 15f...) will not offer a wager combining both halves of the same betting interest (ie. 1-1, 2-2, field-field). If the same betting interest finishes first and second, the exactor payout will be on those horses finishing first and third.

Daily Double & Late Double Betting

Where the daily double feature is operated, the daily double is a betting transaction in which the purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the winners of each of the two races specified for the daily double and that if the purchaser of a daily double ticket fails to pick the winner of the first half of the daily double his bet is void and that all tickets in the second half of the daily double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the daily double are void no matter what circumstances might affect the programmed running of the second half of the daily double. The daily double is operated as an entirely separate pool and is not affected by wagering in other pools operated on the daily double races. Should a horse or horses (not coupled with a starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the daily double after the first race of the daily double has been declared official, holders of all daily double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the daily double race, shall participate in the Consolation Double pool.

Exacta Betting

Where the exacta feature is operated, the exacta is a betting transaction in which the purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two horses to finish, in the exact order of finish, in the race on which the feature is operated.

Trifecta Betting

A Trifecta bet is a betting transaction in which the purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first three horses representing different betting interests to finish, in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the feature is operated.

Superfecta Betting

A Superfecta bet is a betting transaction in which the purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first four horses representing different betting interests to finish, in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the feature is operated.

Super Hi-5 Betting

The Super Hi-5 wager is a betting transaction in which the purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first five horses representing different betting interests to finish, in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the feature is operated. In the event no one correctly selects all five winners in order, 100 per cent of the net pool will be carried over to the next Super Hi-5 race.

Pick-3 or Pick-4 Betting

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively. Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

Pick 5 Betting

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively. If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

Pick 3, Pick 4 & Pick 5 Scratches

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection. However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

Pari-Mutuel Deductions

The Association deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed on Grand River Raceway in Ontario which are then shared with the horsepeople. Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers and an additional 2% on trifecta wagering. The Ontario Government retains .5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government retains .8% on all wagers placed in Canada.
Win, Place, Show: 13.65%, Exacta: 17.2%, Trifecta: 21.7%, Super: 23%; all other pools: 11.7%.

Allowances

Allowances for Ontario Sired horses at Signature tracks is 50% and are based on the condition of the class. Allowances for purse earnings at Signature tracks are 25% for fillies and mares (vs colts and geldings) and are based on the conditions of the race only.

Rule 7.15

No association shall allow a person under 18 years of age to purchase or cash a ticket. For the purposes of this rule, a "ticket" is defined as a receipt or voucher that is issued by an association for one or more bets on a race or races. The association shall ensure that signs are clearly posted in all areas, or in application forms, where tickets are purchased or cashed, advising the public of the age restriction.

Advance Notice Of New Bet Cancellation Options

No claim shall be considered for tickets thrown away, lost, changed, destroyed or mutilated beyond recognition. Payment of wagers will only be made upon presentation of valid parimutuel tickets. The following Bet Cancellation Policy is in effect at Grand River Raceway and the Grand River Teletheatre site. A bet can be cancelled up until "stop betting" for the following reasons: 1) A wrong ticket (even after you have left the mutual window) e.g. wrong track; 2) A change in race surface (turf - dirt) or race distance; 3) A scratch of part of an entry (1-1A) or part of a field Self Serve Cancellation; Cancellation of Self Serve Tickets via mutual sellers (see below)

Mutuel Teller Cancellation

1) Open cancellation: ticket must be cancelled prior to stop betting of the race.
2) For tickets of \$100 or more you must write your name, address and telephone number on the back of the ticket before requesting the cancellation. You will also be required to present 1 piece of photo identification to the teller.

When your bets cannot be cancelled:

1) After a pool has been closed (ie betting has been stopped)
2) For tickets of \$100 or more, if photo ID is not presented or a full name, address and telephone number has not been legibly written on the back of the ticket
3) Under circumstances affecting the integrity of a pool or display of pari-mutuel data
4) An officer or the association refuses to cancel and refund the bet under subsection 57
