



1. Contest entry is FREE. All participants must be of legal age in the Province, State or Country of residence. Ontario participants must be 18 years of age or older.
2. Entry forms will be posted to the Grand River Raceway website and Facebook page before noon on each race day. Players must submit their online forms before 6:15 on each race night to qualify for that evening's contest. One contest entry per person, per contest night. Multiple entries will disqualify all entries.
3. Contestants must select one (1) horse in race **TWO (2), THREE (3), FOUR (4), FIVE (5), SIX (6) and SEVEN (7)** at Grand River Raceway on the contest day.
4. Contestants will be awarded points based on where their selected horse placed in each race. The official results, as posted by AGCO Judges shall constitute the official and final results for this contest. Scoring is based on the following point system:
1st : 50 points 2nd : 25 points 3rd : 12 points 4th : 8 points
5. Contestants will also enter a scratch substitute in the event your main selection is a late scratch. If both horses are scratched, the player will receive the post-time favourite.
6. Contestants will be ranked in order of their point accumulation and the contestant with the highest points will be deemed the winner. The contestant with the second highest points will be the second place finisher, and so on.
7. Contests are conducted each Monday and Friday race night starting June 8th. Some dates will be exempt to contests at the discretion of Grand River Raceway.
8. The 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners shall receive their prize amount deposited to their HPI account. In the event that the contest winner is not a member of HPI Bet, or the winner does not want to sign up for HPIBet, then they will forfeit their prize and instead be playing for pride.
9. In each contest, the prizes will be awarded as follows:
1st Place: \$50 HPIBet credit 2nd Place: \$30 HPIBet credit 3rd Place: \$20 HPIBet credit
10. In the event of a tie a random draw amongst the tied players will determine the standings and prize amounts.
11. Nightly winners will be contacted through the email that was provided on the contest form. The winners will also be posted to the Grand River Raceway website and Facebook page. Skill-testing question required upon receipt of prize.
12. Current Grand River Raceway staff and Grand River Agricultural Society Board members are not permitted to participate in this contest.
13. Licensed racing participants are eligible to participate in the contests, except in any contest races in which they are listed as the owner, trainer or driver of record. Failure to comply will result in automatic disqualification from the contest.
14. Contest winners agree to allow Grand River Raceway to use their name and image in respect to any promotional or media release concerning the contest.
15. If Grand River Raceway cancels any/all of the races spanning from 2 – 7, the contest may be cancelled and not rescheduled.
